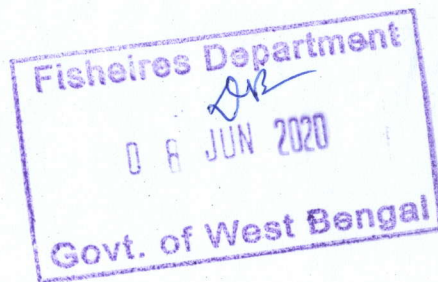
In view of the above, we request you to extend the time for joint assessment survey of damages and losses up to 30th June, 2020.
