





1/4/88-PER (Pt. I)

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Group 'C' and Group 'D', Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted posts, in the Directorate of Fisheries, Government of Goa, namely:

1. **Short title, application and commencement.**— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Directorate of Fisheries, Group 'C' and Group 'D', Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted posts, Recruitment Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall apply to the posts specified in column (2) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number, classification and scale of pay.**— The number of posts, classification of the said posts and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (3) to (5) of the said Schedule.

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts specified in column (3) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.**— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (6) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.**— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having

a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment.

Provided that the Governor is satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law of the person and the other to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.**— Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.**— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.

7. **These rules are issued in supersession of.**— (i) the existing Recruitment Rules for the post of Assistant Superintendent of Fisheries Extension Officer (re-designated as Fisheries Officer), Laboratory Assistant, Mechanical Instructor, Marketing Inspector, Engine Driver, Gram Sevak of Fisheries (re-designated as Fisheries Surveyor), Shore Attendant (re-designated as Net Mending Instructor), Mechanic Grade-I (Diesel), Mechanic Grade-II (Refrigeration), Junior Deckhand-cum-Greaser/Junior Deckhand-cum-Cook/Junior/Deckhand-cum-Net Mender/Junior Deckhand-cum-Shore Attendant, notified vide Government Notification No. 1-4-88-PER dated 9-2-1989, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 4 dated 27-4-1989.

(ii) the Government Notification No. 1/4/88-PER(Pt. I) dated 4-6-2003, published in the Official Gazette, Series I, No. 13 dated 26-6-2003.

(iii) the existing Recruitment Rules for the posts of Carpenter and Fieldman notified vide Government Notification No. 1/15/74-PER Vol. III dated 9-2-1981, published in the Official Gazette, Series I, No. 49 dated 5-3-1981.

Amendment to Scheme "UMMID"

Whereas vide Notification No. 83/6/06/SDV dated 25th July, 2006 published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 23 dated 7th September 2006 (Extraordinary), the Government of Goa framed the Scheme "UMMID".

The existing clause 6.2(h) of the principal scheme is substituted as under:

6.2(h) Rent of premises occupied by Day Care Centre for Senior Citizen by NGOs is to be paid in the following manner.

(a) Rs. 2,500/- p.m. or actual rent fixed by PWD whichever is less in rural areas.

(b) Rs. 5,000/- p.m. or actual rent fixed by PWD whichever is less in urban areas.

This Notification shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

Whereas the Regional Plan 2001 A.D. for the State of Goa has been published in the Official Gazette, Series III No. 37 dated 11-12-1980, for the horizon year 2001;

And Whereas the Government is of the opinion that revision of said Regional Plan 2001 is necessary and accordingly directed Chief Town Planner to undertake the revision of the said Regional Plan 2001;

And Whereas the Government vide Notification No. 29/8/TCP/Pt file/Task Force/R.P/2007/3363 dated 4-10-2007 published in Official Gazette (Extraordinary No. 3) Series II No. 27 dated 5-10-2007 and Notification No. 29/8/TCP/Pt file/Task force/R.P/07-08/812 dated 26-02-2008 published in Official Gazette (Extraordinary No. 4) Series II No. 47 dated 26-02-2008 had appointed a "Task Force" for guiding the preparation of the Regional Plan for Goa for the horizon year 2021.

And Whereas, the Task Force has carried out necessary survey/studies and deliberations through secondary data and consultative process and submitted the draft Regional Plan for Goa-2021 to the Chief Town Planner;

And Whereas, as per the directions of the Government, the Chief Town Planner placed the said draft Regional Plan for Goa-2021 before the Town and Country Planning Board for its consideration;

And Whereas, the Town and Country Planning Board in its 133rd meeting held on 29-9-2008 has considered and approved the draft Regional Plan for Goa-2021;

And Whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Goa Town and Country Planning Act, 1974 (Goa Act 21 of 1975), the draft Regional Plan for Goa-2021

was notified in the Official Gazette, vide Notification No. 29/8/TCP/2008/RP-21/PT/3743 dated 08-10-2008, published in the Official Gazette, Series II No. 29 dated 10-10-2008 inviting comments in writing from the public on the said draft Regional Plan for Goa-2021;

And Whereas, the comments received from the public as well as from the local bodies were studied and considered by the State Level Committee constituted by the Government for the purpose vide Order No. 29/8/TCP/TF/RP-202/VPM/08/4001 dated 29-10-08, No. 29/8/TCP/TF/RP-2021/VPM/08/4507 dated 28-11-08 and No. 29/8/TCP/TF/RP-2021/VPM/08-09/738 dated 12-2-08 and the Regional Plan for Goa-2021 (Surface Utilization Plan) pertaining to Satari Taluka along with Settlement Level Plans of twelve Village Panchayats and one Municipal Council, Ponda Taluka along with Settlement Level Plans of nineteen Village Panchayats and Quepem Taluka along with Settlement Level Plan of eleven Village Panchayats and two Municipal Councils with large use table was finalized (hereinafter referred to as the "said areas");

And Whereas the Town and Country Planning Board in its 137th (Adj) meeting held on 14-01-2011 and 137th (Adj) third sitting of the meeting held on 4-3-11 has considered and approved Regional Plan for Goa-2021 (Surface Utilization Plan) in respect of the said areas;

And whereas the Government has constituted the new Darbandora Taluka, vide Notification No. 16-15-2010/RD dated 16-1-2011 published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 51 dated 17-3-2011, consisting of the villages as specified therein, including Usao and Gangem villages;

And Whereas the Government has approved the Regional Plan for Goa-2021 (Part) on 13-4-2011, in respect of Satari Taluka along with Settlement Level Plans of twelve Village Panchayats and one Municipal Council, Ponda Taluka along with Settlement Level Plans of eighteen Village Panchayats excluding Usao Village Panchayat which is the part of said Darbandora Taluka and Quepem Taluka along

with Settlement Level Plans of eleven Village Panchayats and two Municipal Councils with land use table.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 read with section 17 of the Goa Town and Country Planning Act, 1974 (Goa Act 21 of 1975), I, Shri Morad Ahmad, Chief Town Planner, Government of Goa, hereby notify the Regional Plan for Goa-2021 (Part) in respect of Satari Taluka along with Settlement Level Plan of twelve Village Panchayats and one Municipal Council, Ponda Taluka along with Settlement Level Plan of eighteen Village Panchayats excluding said Usagao Village Panchayat and Quepem Taluka along with Settlement Level Plans of eleven Village Panchayats and two Municipal Councils with land use table as approved by the Government.

On and from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette, all development programme undertaken by any private institution or by any other person within the area covered under said Regional Plan for Goa-2021 (Part), shall conform to the provisions of such Regional Plan. However, public projects/schemes/development works, undertaken by the Central Government or by the State Government, shall be in conformity with the rules framed and procedures laid down by the Government for such projects/schemes/development works.

No person shall undertake any work of development in contravention of any provision of the Regional Plan as in force, except the projects/schemes/development works undertaken by the Central Government or the State Government, either by himself or through

his servant or agent or any other person and all such development work shall be in conformity with the provisions of the Regional Plan.

The Regional Plan for Goa-2021 (Part) (Surface Utilization Plan) in respect of Satari Taluka along with Settlement Level Plan of twelve Village Panchayats and one Municipal Council, Ponda Taluka along with Settlement Level Plan of eighteen Village Panchayats and Quepem Taluka along with Settlement Level Plans of eleven Village Panchayats and two Municipal Councils with land use table are available for the purpose of inspection in the office of the (a) Town and Country Planning Department (Headquarters), Dempo Tower, 2nd Floor, Patto Plaza, Panaji-Goa, (b) North Goa District Office, Town and Country Planning Department, 2nd Floor, Government Office Complex, Mapusa, Bardez-Goa, (c) South Goa District Office, Town and Country Planning Department, Osia Complex, 4th Floor, Margao-Goa, (d) Bicholim Taluka Office, Town and Country Planning Department, PMC Commercial Complex, Bicholim-Goa, (e) Quepem Taluka Office, Town and Country Planning Department, Government Office Complex, Quepem Town, Goa and (f) Ponda Taluka Office, Town and Country Planning Department, Government Building, 2nd Floor, Near Municipal Garden.
